Location

- Thiel College is located on a 135-acre, tree-lined campus in Greenville, Pa., a small town in the heart of Western Pennsylvania's hill country.
- Only 90 minutes from Pittsburgh, Cleveland and Erie—Thiel has ready access to "big city" culture, but is distant enough to be safe and free from distractions.

History

- Founded as co-educational Thiel Hall in Monaca, Pa., in 1866; chartered by Pennsylvania in 1870 and moved to Greenville in 1871.
- Affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.

Students

- Thiel's fall 2011 enrollment is 1,109; 46.5% are female and 53.5% are male.
- 61% from Pennsylvania; 39% from other states & Puerto Rico; 4% international students; and 13% minority students.

- More than 60 majors, minors and areas of study.
- Academic calendar: Semesters: fall and spring; Summer sessions: May, June, July, Online and Evening.
- Degrees offered: Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, Associate of Arts, Associate of Science

Faculty/Classes

- Student-to-faculty ratio is 13-to-1.
- More than 65% of classes have 20 or fewer students.
- More than 113 full- and part-time faculty in 19 academic departments.

Student Support

- Located in the Langenheim Library, the Learning Commons offers tutoring services, academic guidance, writing and math labs, and special needs accommodations.
- All incoming students receive a notebook computer as part of Thiel's technology initiative.

Living on Campus

- 89% of students live on campus in nearly 30 residence halls, apartments, theme houses and townhouses.
- Guaranteed housing for four years.
- Other facilities include a fitness center, multi-sport air-supported dome, theater, cafeteria and bistro dining.

Activities

- 24 varsity athletic teams, most competing in NCAA Division III.
- More than 50 student clubs and organizations, including the Tomcat Marching Pride band.
- Greek life includes one local and three national fraternities and four national sororities.

Financials 2011-2012

- Budget: \$25.9 million
- Endowment: \$24.3 million

Scholarships and Financial Aid

- More than 98% of students receive some form of financial assistance.
- For consideration for Merit Awards of up to \$11,500 or one of five full-tuition Presidential Scholarships, a complete admissions application should be submitted by January 15.
