



## A Year in "The Dome"

The Rissell-Schreyer Dome, an air-supported structure that covers the multi-use athletic field at Alumni Stadium during winter months, was installed on Nov. 15, 2010, celebrated at a grand opening on Dec. 3, 2010, and ended its first year of service on April 30, 2011.
