As a result of the new guidance, the College is planning to provide special housing for students impacted by this recommendation at no additional cost to the students involved. Ideally, we'd like to plan to have you return to campus for **Saturday, August 1**. At that time, we would house you in one of our Davis Square apartment buildings for the quarantine period. We will also be providing meals for each student at no cost throughout their early arrival and stay.

The Office of Admission will be reaching out to incoming first-year students and The Office of Student Life will be reaching out to returning students by phone to answer any questions you may have, and to work with you on planning your arrival for the fall semester. In the meantime, we wanted to alert you of this new guidance and our plans to accommodate you throughout your transition back to campus.

As mentioned, we are very excited to have the privilege of bringing our students back to campus to live and learn together in community, and we are here to support you throughout that process.
