## WHAT ARE MY HOUSING OPTIONS?

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Student housing for 2019-2020 offers three options—residence halls, theme housing (includes Greeks, clubs, learning communities and organizations), apartments or townhouses, and residence halls. Most residence halls are co-ed; single sex by floor or wing. Apartments and townhouses are co-ed by building but not by unit. **Freshman:** Florence West (nicknamed Flo), Sawhill, and Hodge Hall are available for first year students.

**Upperclassmen:** Apartments and townhouses, theme houses, Bane Hall, and Stewart Hall are available for upper class students.

## NEED A PRIVATE ROOM DUE TO MEDICAL REASONS?

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\*Private room availability is limited. Those with a medical need for a private room have first priority. All medical housing accommodation requests must be made through the Disability Services Office (Clarissa Arbuckle - 724-589-2063). The second set of furniture MUST be left in student rooms even if it is a private room.

## NO ROOMMATE?

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If your roommate does not move in or later moves out, you may either choose a roommate or ask the Housing Coordinator to choose a roommate for you. You may also ask the Housing Coordinator to mark your room as private if you are financially approved for premium housing by Student Accounts in Roth Hall. If you are not approved by Student Accounts, you will be paired with a roommate.

All room changes require prior approval through the Housing Coordinator. Unauthorized room changes will result in a fine of \$25.00 per day.
