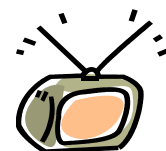

WHAT TO BRING!

FURNISHINGS PROVIDED

- ___ Coin operated automatic washers and dryers
- ___ Bed and mattress
- ___ Desk and chair
- ___ Window Blinds
- ___ Dresser or wardrobe/closet
- ___ Vacuum Cleaner (1 per hall)

NECESSARY ITEMS TO BRING

- ___ Pillow, sheets (twin x-long), blanket(s), bedspread
- ___ Alarm clock
- ___ Desk lamp, light bulbs (non-halogen)
- ___ Laundry bag/basket and detergent
- ___ Towels, washcloths
- ___ Wastebasket
- ___ Backpack
- ___ Personal toiletries
- ___ Shower caddy
- ___ Umbrella/Rain Gear
- ___ Academic Supplies (pens, pencils, notebooks, stapler, file folders, tape, etc.)

SUGGESTED ITEMS TO BRING

- ___ Coins for vending machines (quarters) (there is also a coin machine in the HMSC)
- ___ Clothes drying rack (small)
- ___ Mattress Pad for comfort (twin x-long)
- ___ Surge protector
- ___ Extension cords
- ___ Hangers (space savers are best)
- ___ Iron/Ironing Board
- ___ Small bulletin board with wire and hanger
- ___ Shower shoes/flip flops

SUGGESTED ITEMS CONTINUED

- ___ Sports equipment
- ___ Sticky tack (for hanging posters, etc.)
- ___ Posters/pictures
- ___ Radio/Stereo/Television/DVD
- ___ Carpet/Throw Rug(s) – you may want to wait until after you move in and see how your room is arranged.
- ___ Crates
- ___ Small Fan (window fans **NOT** permitted)
- ___ Message Board (for door)
- ___ Mugs, cups, glasses, eating utensils, etc.
- ___ Camera
- ___ Can Opener
- ___ Sewing Kit/First Aid Kit
- ___ Snacks, Juice, etc.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Do **not** bring a water mattress!
- Do **not** bring a microwave oven or toaster!
- Do **not** bring any pets (see pet policy in student handbook)!
- Do **not** bring an AC unit or window fan!

COMPACT REFRIGERATORS

Refrigerators are not to be larger than approximately 4.5 cubic feet.
