<ul> <li>Any valuables such as credit cards, cash, travelers checks, laptop, MP3 player, digital camera (with charger), etc.</li> <li>Cell phone (it's invaluable if you miss a flight or travel plans have been delayed and you need to contact someone)</li> <li>A change of clothes</li> </ul>
Toiletries (toothbrush, deodorant, etc.) Most toiletries can be purchased in the USA, so pack only the name brand items that you think will be difficult to find abroad Eye glasses or contact lenses and solution
CLOTHING:
Several short and long sleeve shirts
2-3 hooded sweatshirts
A few sweaters
Several pairs of jeans, pants, and shorts A belt or two
Skirts (for females)
A set or two of workout clothes
Pajamas
Swimsuit
Coat/Jacket (one for colder weather and one for rainy days)
One formal outfit
One traditional outfit (for different on-campus cultural activities)
Flip-flops or sandals
Sneakers, dress shoes, and boots
Undergarments and socks

Please note: You will have many opportunities to shop for clothing while you are here. However, you might want to bring your most favorite clothing items with you.
