



Important Check-In Information for New Commuter Students

When?

Commuting students may begin the check-in process on **Saturday, August 26, 2023** between 1:00pm. – 1:45 pm.

Where?

Upon arrival the area around campus, please follow the signs to the **Passavant Center Parking Lot**, park your vehicle in the lower lot, and walk to the Howard Miller Student Center across the street. Once in the building, you will be greeted by a Student Life team member and receive your Welcome Weekend information folder.

Commuter students who arrive closer to 1pm and/or earlier will have time to stop by the Community Vendors located outside the Student Center. Local businesses and campus offices will have tables and tents set-up to provide you valuable information. There is also a complimentary lunch tent set-up, which will serve hotdogs, chips, and cookies.

All students will be provided dinner on campus. Following the meal, Commuter students will meet at 7 p.m. in Bly Hall, located inside the Academic Center.
