## **Did you know you can earn credit toward your high school diploma while earning college credits to Thiel College at the same time?**

Thiel College helps bridge the gap between high school and college-level study through College in High School (CHS). Participating in rigorous college-level work while in high school contributes to a student's overall development and success and may help students reach their academic goals faster.

CHS allows students to earn college credit *at reduced tuition* for college-level courses taken at their high school. These credits can be used to pursue a degree at Thiel or transferred to another institution.

## **The Benefits of College in High School**

Thiel College partners with several Western Pennsylvania high schools to enable sophomore, junior and senior high school students earn credit toward a college degree.

- Students take college-level courses in their own high school classroom.
- Credits are earned at Thiel College and are transferable to most other colleges.
- Tuition for CHS courses is a fraction of regular college tuition.

- The student is a sophomore, junior or senior at a partnered high school.
- The student and their family completes the registration below.
- Cost: Total course cost: **\$287.**  
This discounted rate reflects a savings of almost \$3,000.
