ADDITIONAL NOTES REGARDING TESTING:

- Drop-in testing (for any student) will not be permitted. **ALL students MUST sign-up in advance and by the deadline of MAY 1, 2025 at 12:00 PM. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS AFTER THIS DATE AND TIME.**
- If a test proctor has reason to believe that a student is violating the honor code during testing, the proctor will take the test and all materials. TLC/ARC staff will document the incident and immediately notify faculty to resolve the issue. All students are expected to follow the Academic Honor Code. All students will review the Academic Honor Code, sign off they have read and agree to Code, prior to starting the exams (these are posted in all testing rooms) and follow the testing rules (i.e. no hoodies, coats, cell phones, food, smart watches etc.) while taking exams. **No restroom breaks will be permitted** during testing.
- ARC students who have multiple exams, on the same day, will be encouraged to take a break between exams.
- **ARC students are expected to take their exams as close to their scheduled final exams as possible and as space allows.** Changes to the day/time of the final need to be approved by the instructor prior to scheduling.
