



Advanced Placement (AP) Policy

Thiel College participates in the Advanced Placement Program as instituted by the College Entrance Examination Board. Advanced placement and credit may be granted to admitted students who show satisfactory scores on the Advanced Placement Examinations of the College Entrance Examination Board.

A score of five on an advanced placement examination will result in exempt status from the equivalent course and the awarding of appropriate credit hours for that course.

A score of four will result in exemption from the equivalent course. No credit hours will be awarded. Language courses (French, German, Latin, Spanish) earned result in 1 semester of equivalency.

Scores of three and below will not be considered.
