## **APPLICATION Requirements**

- Currently enrolled as an undergraduate in the Communication Sciences and Disorders program
- Senior-level CSD major meeting the following requirements:
- Minimum 3.0 overall cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale with no more than two Cs in required CSD coursework including biology, chemistry or physics, and statistics by graduation from undergraduate program
- Complete a successful interview with Thiel MS-SLP program faculty

## **APPLICATION Procedures**

- **All students must apply using the CSDCAS by September 1 of their senior year. CSDCAS opens for current cycle on July 15.**
  - Create account and submit application to Thiel Early Assurance Program.
    - Submit contact information for 3 references.
      - One must be your department chairperson
      - Email will be sent to each reference with link for them to upload their recommendation
  - Upload the following:
    - Personal statement/letter of intent that addresses the following: The Thiel College MS-SLP program expects students to be professional, inquisitive, and empathetic. What other qualities will you bring to the program that will help you prepare to be a competent clinician?
    - Transcripts for all undergraduate coursework
      - Mailed to: CSDCAS Transcript Processing Center, PO Box 9113, Watertown, MA 02471
    - Résumé
- **Applicants will be contacted via email to schedule an interview after all required application materials have been received and reviewed.**
- **All applicants must complete an interview before a final admission decision will be made.**

Students who intend to enroll must sign their admission letters and submit non-refundable \$500 deposit to Thiel College MS-SLP program no later than 30 days after notification of admission to MS-SLP Program.



## IMPORTANT Notes

Students' admission to Thiel College MS-SLP program will not be final until submission of a final transcript, showing completion of the bachelor's degree with an acceptable record or a letter from undergraduate department chairperson confirming this information until final transcript is available. During the year between their admission and enrollment, students admitted under the Early Assurance program will be obligated to maintain a grade point average, disciplinary record, and overall academic/personal profile consistent with the profile they represented on their original application. Thiel College MS-SLP program may, at its sole discretion and without prior warning, revoke a student's admission in the event of any changes in the student's criminal history, academic profile, or personal profile during the period between admission and enrollment
