

APPLICATION Procedures

- All students must apply using the CSDCAS. CSDCAS opens for current cycle on July 15.
- **Required information:**
 - Personal statement/letter of intent that addresses the following: The Thiel College MS-SLP program expects students to be professional, inquisitive, and empathetic. What other qualities will you bring to the program that will help you prepare to be a competent clinician?
 - Résumé and Transcript.
- **Provide contact information for three references.**
 - References will be sent a system-generated email with instructions for completing recommendation.
- **Applicants will be contacted via email to schedule the interview after all required application materials have been received and reviewed.**
- All applicants must complete an interview before a final admission decision will be made.
