Tuition and Fees Refund Policy

A pro-rata refund of all tuition, fees, room and board costs will be given through the 10th week of a regular semester should a student withdraw from the College. The tuition costs are as follows:

- **Week 2:** 20%
- **Week 3:** 30%
- **Week 4:** 40%
- **Week 5:** 50%
- **Week 6:** 60%
- **Week 7:** 70%
- **Week 8:** 80%
- **Week 9:** 90%
- **Week 10:** 100%

Financial aid recipients who withdraw from the College may be required to return a portion of their financial aid to the federal programs. The policy is subject to change in accordance with revisions in federal regulations. The student must contact the Office of Financial Aid and Student Accounts prior to withdrawal, to review his/her financial status and obligations.

Employment while enrolled in the PA Program

The program does not encourage students to work during the didactic or clinical years of the program. The program will not make any exceptions, due to outside employment, in regard to course work or clinical assignments for the student who does engage in outside employment.
