### *Frequently Asked Questions*

#### *What makes the Speech-Language Pathology program at Thiel different from others?*

Our 14-month on-campus accelerated program provides intensive knowledge of scientific and cultural foundations of human communication in the classroom and hands-on experiences in our campus clinic.

#### *How much does it cost to pursue a Speech-Language Pathology degree at Thiel College?*

All tuition and program fees, a laptop and equipment are included in the total sum for this 14-month master's degree program. The total cost for this program is **\$61,372**.

#### *When does each cohort of students begin?*

Classes begin in January or June of each year on campus through December. Students then spend the rest of the program in rotations either in a medical placement or a school district.

#### *What is required for admission to the Speech-Language Pathology Program?*

Students are required to submit an application through the CSDCAS platform and submit undergraduate transcripts to show a 3.0 cumulative GPA, three letters of recommendation and a personal statement as to why the student is interested in the program.

#### *Is the program accredited?*

Yes. This program is accredited by the Council on Academic Accreditation for Speech-Language Pathology.

#### *What is the PRAXIS pass rate?*

96% of students who have taken the exam have passed.

#### *Where are clinical rotations held?*

Students can have their rotation anywhere in the United States. It may even be in our on-campus clinic.

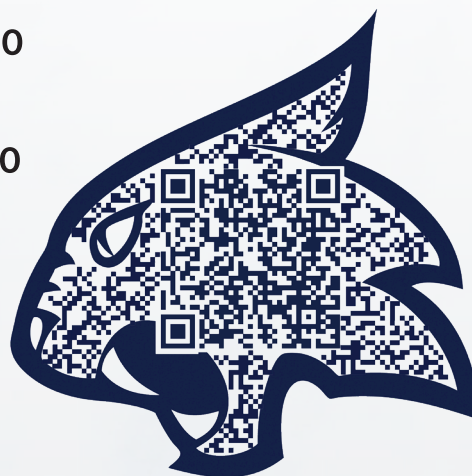
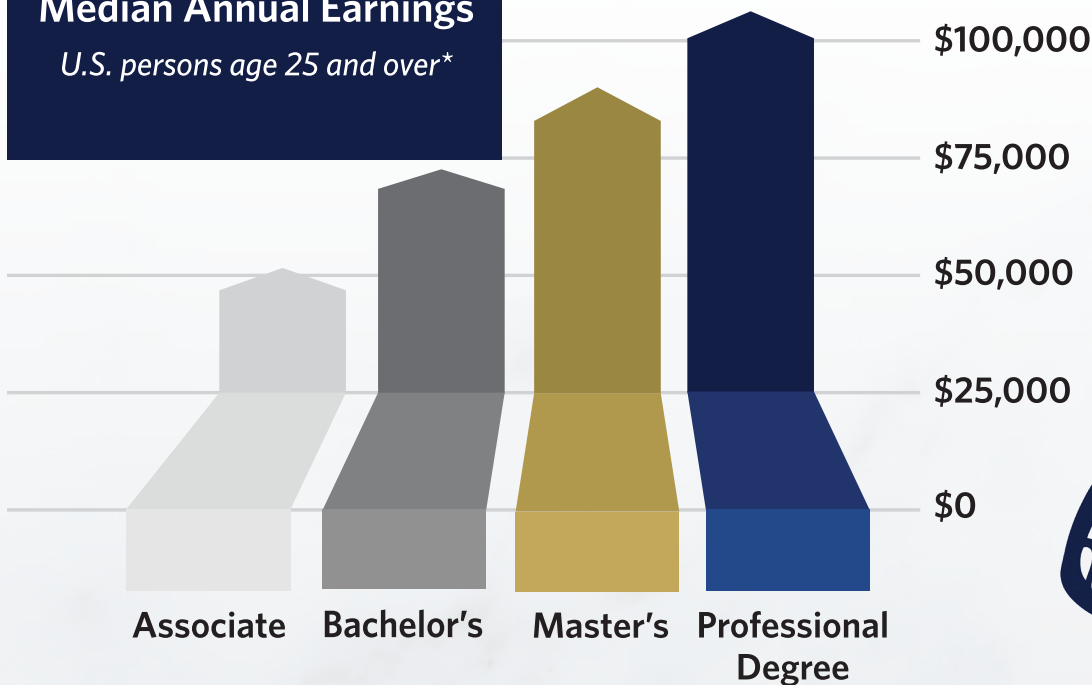
